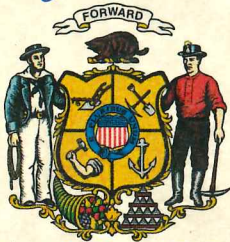

*WHEREAS*; the United Way kicks off its annual campaign every fall in order to support those efforts;


*NOW, THEREFORE*, I, Scott Walker, Governor of the State of Wisconsin,

throughout the State of Wisconsin and I commend this observance to all of our citizens.


