FOCUS FOOD PANTRY

FREE OR REDUCED LUNCH PROGRAMS

BACKPACK PROGRAMS

FOCUS FAMILY BACKPACKS

Provides nutritious foods needed to make a family meal along with an easy-to-follow recipe. Program is provided to select schools in Wisconsin Rapids for the school year beginning in October. Contact the school's social worker or counselor for more information or to request a backpack.

THE BACKPACK FOR KIDS PROGRAM

THE FAMILY CENTER

STOCKBOX PROGRAM

Provides free, supplemental food to qualifying seniors. Stockboxes contain 25-30lbs of nutritious, non-perishable food items. Must be age 60 or older with monthly income below \$1,473 to qualify.
